INTRODUCTORY NOTE

This directory contains the names and addresses of physicians who are authorized to perform physical examinations and issue airman medical certificates for the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration. This 2000 edition follows the same format as previous editions, and contains updated Aviation Medical Examiner information compiled through July, 2000. All Aviation Medical Examiners located in the United States and its territories are authorized to conduct airman physical examinations for Second and Third Class Medical Certificates. They are also authorized to issue the combined Medical-Student Pilot Certificate. Aviation Medical Examiners authorized to issue First Class Medical Certificates are identified by an (*) asterisk symbol.

Part 61 of the Federal Aviation Regulations describes the various types of airman operations and indicates the class of medical certification required.

Physicians interested in becoming Aviation Medical Examiners should request application forms from the FAA Regional Flight Surgeon.
